Discovery Bible Study Meeting Elements

- 1) Ask everyone to share something for which they are thankful.
- 2) Ask everyone to share something about which they have concern (a need).
- 3) Read the Scripture again. Typically the 1st and 2nd columns would have been done prior to the meeting. Ask if there are any questions about the passage of Scripture and allow the group to help address these questions.
- 4) Ask everyone to share what they will do based on their understanding of the Scripture (3rd C).
- 5) Ask everyone if there are other people whom they know that would like or need to hear the story (Scripture) that the group has discussed.
- 6) Begin each subsequent DBS Meeting with how each person did with living out their 3rd column.
